
Important Information for Training Participants

This guide will help you set up your account, access curriculum materials, and place orders for Scottish Rite for Children dyslexia curricula.

Create a New Account

Account Request Form

Use the account Request Form – click “New Account”: <https://tsrh-338574.workflowcloud.com/forms/1e13d326-b5a6-42b7-b14e-c6dabf368a3f>



Complete the form thoroughly. **All personal accounts must only have personal information. *All school accounts must only have school information, and you must submit a tax-exempt form when requesting an account. *You must also include the training facility name (The Written Word Center for Dyslexia and Learning) and the training instructor (Tara Chapman).*

- Once you have completed and submitted the form, it will be reviewed to ensure all information is correct. You will then receive a "Welcome Email" from adminupress@quad.com with a user ID (your email address) and a "temporary" password. Please create your own password once approved.
- If the correct information is not received, you will receive an email requesting the missing information. If there is no response to your account request, it will be denied.

School Accounts

If materials will be purchased through your school or district:

- Use your school email address
- Use your school's name and address
- Submit a tax-exempt certificate with your account request
- The account name should match the purchase order or the school payment method

Personal Accounts

If purchasing materials personally:

- Use your personal email address
- Use your personal billing address
- The account name should match the credit card being used

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
Updating to Existing Account

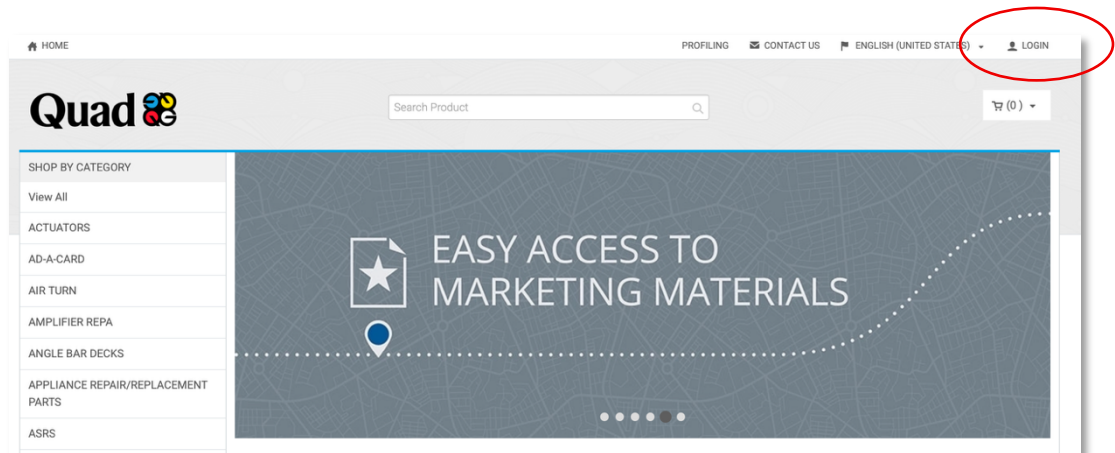

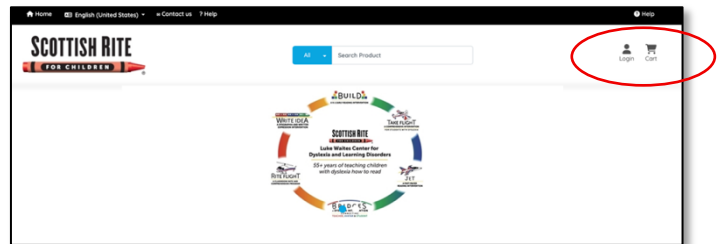
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Place Your Curriculum Order

Important Ordering Policies

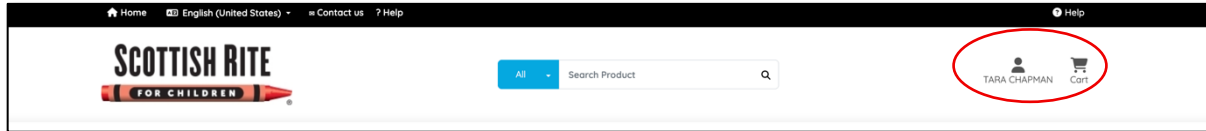
- Orders are not held pending documentation.

- All sales are final.

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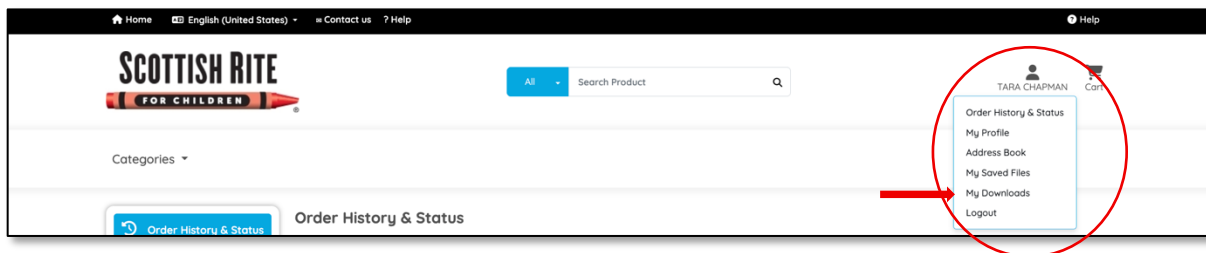

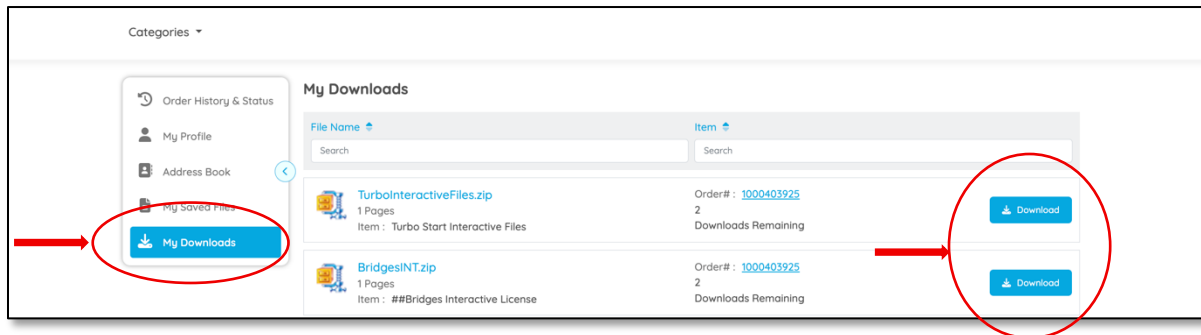

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Reporting Order Problems


If your order arrives with:
